Out of Eden Learn is an online learning community and research project accompanying journalist Paul Salopek on his 21,000 mile-long journey across the world on foot, the Out of Eden Walk.

Students from around the world participate in *Out of Eden Learn*. The project's approach to cross-cultural inquiry and exchange invites young people to slow down and observe the world carefully, share their stories and perspectives, and explore how their lives connect to bigger human stories. The curriculum especially encourages young people to look more closely at their everyday surroundings. *Uncovering the Everyday* celebrates this work.
